Curriculum Development workshop on 'Waste Treatment and Valorization Technologies in Sri Lanka'



he Department of Manufacturing Technology of University of Vocational Technology organized a Curriculum Development Workshop on 'WasteTreatment and Valorization Technologies' under the purview of Techno-Economic-Societal Sustainable Development Training in Sri Lanka funded by the European Union through its Erasmus+ Capacity

Building in Higher Education Program. The University of South-Eastern Norway is the primary coordinator of this project. The grant will be used to introduce both bachelor and master degree educational programs on Waste Treatment and Valorization Technologies at the University of Vocational Technology and the University of Jaffna. New educational programs aim at catering to the problems and issues in waste disposal with environmental and societal sustainability. Senior Prof. Ranjith Premalal de Silva, Vicè Chancellor of the University of Vocational Technology, highlighted the significance of empowering youth in technological development and changing attitudes toward environmental sustainability. The principal coordinator and chief guest at the inaugural ceremony, Prof. Chamara Kuruppu of the University of South-Eastern Norway, emphasized the importance of waste treatment technologies by developing new interdisciplinary programs and redesigning existing programs, focusing more on employability through the contribution of Institutions related to the Higher Education sector in Sri Lanka.

It is expected to improve the establishment and restructuring of existing courses, as well as teacher training workshops, workshops designed to actively contribute to the knowledge of the student community, collaboration with industry and the involvement of local municipalities as related partners.

As a result, future graduates will be better prepared to address Sri Lanka's waste management challenges. to improve the quality of life for ordinary citizens, and create new employment opportunities. This is in line with both Institutional and National interests, European priorities, and Sustainable Development Goals adopted by the United Nations. The project team was chosen based on their knowledge and interest in these areas of study.

To achieve a more comprehensive approach to the waste management problem, experts from business management and engineering have been brought together. A group of engineering and technical management experts from four European Universities, five Sri Lankan Universities and JanathakshanaGte Ltd collaborate on this project. The European contributions include the University of South-Eastern Norway, Universidade Nova de Lisboa, Technical University of Denmark, and the University of Essex, while the national contributions from the Universities of Moratuwa, Sri Jayewardenepura, Ruhuna, Jaffna, and Vocational Technology with Janathakshana representing the Industry. The program envisions long-term waste management in order to create a green environment with healthy communities and a legacy of less natural environmental damage. This workshop was held at the Galadari Hotel in Colombo from April 4 to April 8, 2022.
